In order to ensure a continuity of instruction while also meeting staff and students' mental health needs, the district has implemented a number of resources to meet this need including additional counseling support at schools, increased SEL time (specifically at the K - 8 level) as well as parental training programs so that the supports are available through the home.

The LEA described these supports during the November 2021 BOE meeting and opened for public comment on them. Many of these supports are being funded through ARP in addition to ESSER II.
